In contrast, the summer brings opportunities for hiking, mountain biking, and scenic wine tours in the nearby Central Otago region, famous for its world-class Pinot Noir.

The South Island also boasts vibrant cities like Christchurch and Dunedin, each offering its unique cultural experiences. Christchurch, often referred to as the "Garden City," has undergone significant transformation since the 2011 earthquake, emerging as a city of innovation and resilience. It features a mix of contemporary art, historical landmarks, and beautifully restored parks like the Botanic Gardens. Dunedin, with its rich Scottish heritage, offers a blend of historic architecture and wildlife experiences.
