Shoqafa, one of the Seven Wonders of the Middle Ages. Next, we fly from Cairo to Aswan, a peaceful city on the banks of the Nile. Known for its relaxed vibe and stunning views, Aswan offers a quieter contrast to Cairo's frenetic pace.

Your adventure continues with a 5-star Nile River cruise, offering an indulgent way to explore Egypt's ancient sites while enjoying world-class amenities. Starting in Aswan, the cruise takes you on a scenic journey along the river, passing palm-lined villages and desert landscapes. With inclusions like gourmet dining, luxurious cabins, and guided tours to the historical sites, it's a great way to see the sites in style.

After we see Kom Ombo and Edfu, the final leg of your Nile journey takes you to Luxor, often referred to as the world's greatest open-air museum. Luxor is home to the Karnak Temple Complex and Luxor Temple, both awe-inspiring in their grandeur and history. A walk down the Avenue of Sphinxes connects these two ancient sites, offering a glimpse of the city's past glory. However, no trip to Egypt is complete without visiting the Valley of the Kings. This necropolis on the west bank of the Nile is where Egypt's most powerful pharaohs, including Tutankhamen, were laid to rest. Explore the elaborately decorated tombs and marvel at the intricate hieroglyphics that tell stories of the afterlife.

Rise and shine, as today we are travelling back in time to the home of ancient knowledge. Depart for Alexandria, Egypt's second-largest city, and get the chance to see the panoramic view of the Library of Alexandria. Please note that it is not possible to visit inside the library, as it is closed on Saturdays. Wander through the ruins of one of the most important historical archaeological sites ever found on earth, and choose how far down the historic rabbit hole you want to go. Entry to the Catacombs, Pompey's Pillar and the Citadel are an additional charge. After you've had your daily dose of history and ancient culture, return to Cairo for an overnight stay.

Day 4

Cairo

Set your alarms for 7:30am, and fill up on plenty of breakfast before a big day exploring Egypt's iconic Ancient Wonders of the World - the Pyramids and Sphinx! The journey continues with one of the most important museums dedicated to the ancient world, the Egyptian Museum of Cairo. Home to over 120,000 ancient Egyptian relics and antiquities, this place will leave you in awe.

Day 5

Cairo ✈ Aswan

We start the day with a flight to Aswan, where we will have a city tour with our local guide. Visit the Unfinished Obelisk to get a grasp of the incredible building methods used to create the four-sided, hallmark monuments that are placed at the entrances of Egyptian temples. Take some time to walk along the 42-metre long lying bed of granite, and learn about its significance from your guide. Visit the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis and divine mother of the pharaohs. The temple is set beautifully on an island in the middle of the Nile. Next up, we board our 5-Star Nile Cruiser and check in to our private cabins for three nights on the Nile River.

Kick back, as it's time to relax and enjoy the cool breeze of our cruising experience. Jump on-board a traditional Felucca sailboat, bound for the Elephantine and Kitchener Islands on the Nile. After our river excursion, the rest of the day is yours to wander around Aswan as you wish.

Day 8

Kom Ombo Edfu Luxor

Today we hop back onboard the coach, and drive north towards Kom Ombo. Dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, we'll first visit the Kom Ombo Temple. Next on our journey is Edfu, home to one of the largest and best-preserved temples in Egypt. Dedicated to the falcon god Horus, the temple was built over 180-years from 237 BC to 57 BC. We'll arrive in Luxor in the late afternoon, before checking out the Luxor Temple in the evening. Explore the temple after dark, and learn from your guide about the ancient history of this complex, dating back to the 14th century BC. We'll also visit the vast Karnak Temple Complex, one of the most important religious centres of Ancient Egypt.

Take to the skies on an optional hot air balloon ride over Luxor. Next up, follow your guide to the Valley of the Kings. Also known as the 'City of the Dead', this iconic archaeological site is home to royal tombs carved into desert rocks, and filled with treasures for the pharaohs in the afterlife. We'll also get to see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and Colossi of Memnon. Later in the afternoon, we make our way to the airport and fly back to Cairo.
